SERVICE:

Serves others. Need not be served.

Shares information. Doesn't hog the credit.

Makes every council within his district his own council. Attends their functions, fundraisers and social events as though he was a member of that council.

TRUST:

Because of his actions he becomes a trusted advisor to the Grand Knight and council officers.

Keeps a positive attitude and works with all members to resolve differences in a positive non-threatening way.

Offers suggestions, not dictates.

ACTIONS (absolutely required.)

Attends Both State Meetings. Organizational and Mid year.

Attends and insures that all GK's attend the Two Diocesan Conferences.

Attends the State Convention.

Attends chapter meetings and works on the Chapter functions.

Fully prepares himself for the installation of officers for each council within his district. This requires practice and preparation. The installation should be conducted with dignity and not rushed. It is an important event in the life of the officers involved and you should insure that it is treated as such.

Hosts a First Degree each month.

Attends and participates in Major Degrees

Attends each council meeting.

RELIABILITY:

Keeps promises.

Finds answers to questions, provides the information in a timely manner.

Sets priorities and sticks with commitments.
